



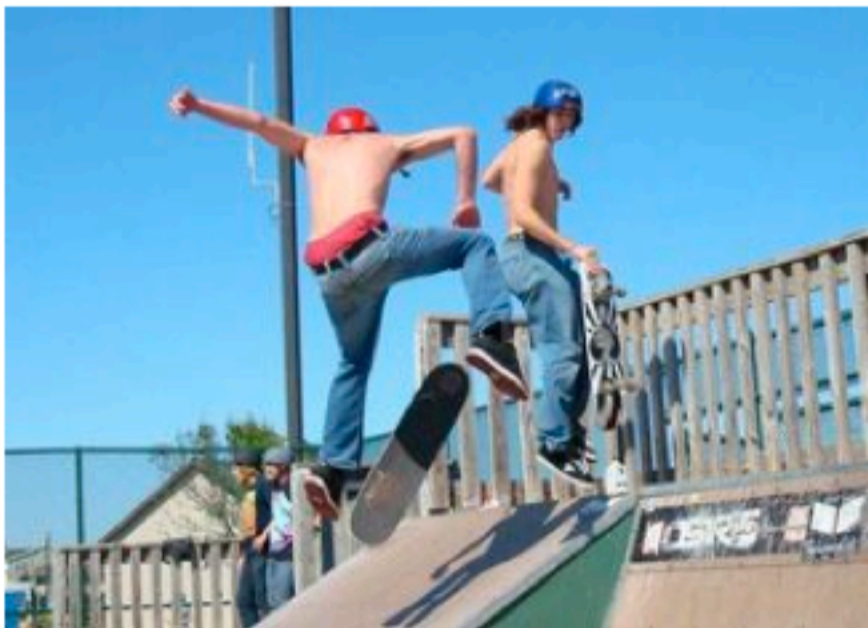

The July 5th Skate Jam will begin at 3 p.m. at the Dealy Field Skateboard Park, 59th and Central Avenue (rain date: July 6).

The event is open to participants of all ages who will compete in various age groups. Parents, family members and friends are encouraged to cheer on the skaters as they display their skills on the park's obstacles, sloping walls and half-pipes.
